The Iberian fortification of Montgròs is a site located on top of a hill surrounded by thick forests within the territory of the Montseny Natural Park.

The wall was discovered in 1974 and defended the only access point to a nine-hectare rocky peninsula that was inhabited since the 10th century BC.
